

## Dangerous goods not permitted / restricted to ship

Some items may endanger the safety of a truck, vessel, aircraft and/or persons (on board of it). The road, sea and air transportation of these dangerous materials can either be forbidden or restricted. This varies per destination.

The goods listed below have been classified as 'Dangerous' in accordance with International Law. Please be aware that you may be liable to prosecution if you attempt to ship dangerous goods.

**PERSONAL CHECKLIST:** the following goods are classified as dangerous and are not permitted:



### Aerosols prohibited / restricted

All aerosols, deodorants, sprays and compressed gas canisters are forbidden

**CHECKLIST:** Are any of the following in your shipment?

- Aerosols?
- Air Fresheners?
- Body Sprays?
- Any other compressed gas cylinders?
- Cigarette lighters?
- Gas cylinders for camping stoves or any other gases?



### Flammable goods prohibited / restricted

All flammable liquids

**CHECKLIST:** Are any of the following in your shipment?

- Household cleaning products?
- Other flammable liquids?



### Toner cartridges or ink

**CHECKLIST:** Are any of the following in your shipment?

- Ink or toner cartridges?

## Other dangerous goods prohibited / restricted



**Explosives**  
Eg. Ammunition, Christmas crackers, fireworks, fuses



**All Oxidizing Substances & Organic Peroxides**  
Eg. Bleach



**Toxic & Infectious Substances**  
Eg. Pesticides, insecticides, mercury, poisons



**Radioactive Materials**



**Corrosive Substances**  
Eg. All battery types, corrosive cleaning fluids, acids and alkalines, thermometers (mercury)



**Miscellaneous Dangerous Goods**  
Eg. Asbestos, magnetized materials, dry ice, self-inflating life jackets

## Dangerous goods not permitted / restricted to ship

### Restricted goods

Restricted goods cannot be transported as personal effects to most countries by road, air or sea.

You are advised to check with Customs in your destination country as to whether such goods are permitted.

#### ANIMAL PRODUCTS



Animal skins (non-domesticated), furs, ivory and live animals

#### PERISHABLE GOODS, PLANTS & SEEDS, PILLS & VITAMINS



Foodstuffs, medicines

#### MONEY, ITEMS OF EXCEPTIONAL VALUE



Money, negotiable items, pre-paid credit cards, jewellery and watches, artworks, antiques, precious stones

#### LIQUIDS



Alcoholic Beverages are not permitted to enter the USA duty free and are restricted in many other countries

#### TOBACCO & TOBACCO PRODUCTS



#### PORNOGRAPHIC MATERIAL



The list of prohibited and restricted items which Gosselin has compiled is a strict informative list. It contains the commodities that are in general prohibited or restricted to import. It is always the shipper's responsibility to ensure the contents of the shipment are in compliance with the regulations of the country of destination.

As each country has different policies as to what will be accepted into the country, we strongly recommend that you check with customs at the destination country that you wish to ship to. If you are in any doubt, please contact our customer services team or your account manager.

The shipper hereby declares that his/her consignment contains none of the goods as described on these pages nor any goods that are not in compliance with the regulations of the country of destination. Where such non permitted or restricted items are found, Gosselin reserves the right to remove these items and dispose of them without reference to the shipper. In such circumstances the shipper will not be due for any compensation, nor will Gosselin be under any obligation to return or forward such items or give any notice that such items have been removed.

In the event a fine and or charge is imposed due to an offense against the local regulations, Gosselin can never be held liable. Shipper agrees to indemnify Gosselin for any and all costs, fees and expenses Gosselin incurs as a result of the shipper's violation of any local, state or federal laws or regulations or from tendering any prohibited item for shipment.
