



## Importation of new items to Switzerland

(in connection with household goods shipment)

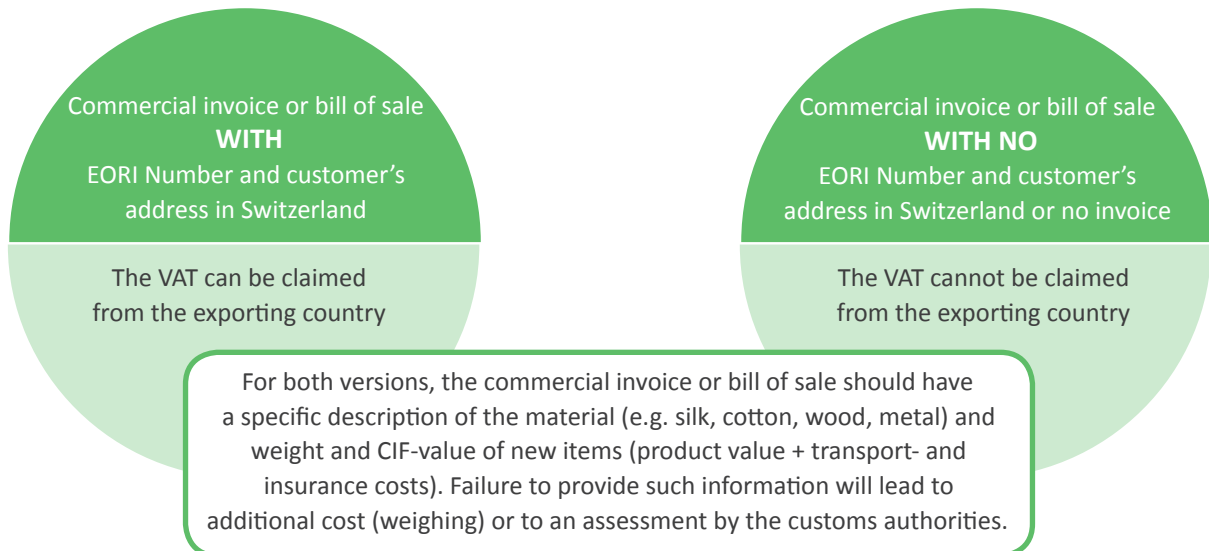
**New items definition:** goods in your ownership and usage for less than 6 months.

Importation of new items require an additional customs clearance. The price for such an additional clearance is CHF 250 per clearance. This price is not included in the quoted moving price unless otherwise noted in the quote.

Importation of new items into Switzerland is also subject to the normal duties and taxes (VAT). These additional costs are not included in the quote either.

Depending the relocation policy these additional costs need to be covered by either transferee or corporate account.

### For customs clearance we need either:



- It is the customer's responsibility to instruct Gosselin accordingly and to provide the required documents well before customs clearance.
- In case of a commercial invoice with EORI Number and address in Switzerland, Gosselin will make the proof of export available to the customer. With this document the customer can claim VAT back from the supplier of the new items.
- Gosselin is only responsible for the transport and the clearance of the goods, however not for the reimbursement of the VAT. If instructed in advance, Gosselin will provide proof of export.
- We caution our customers from shipping new items as 'used household goods'. The authorities have a pretty good eye for such things. The risk is entirely with the new customer.
